## Memo of Understanding for Double Majors

In petitioning for a double major in $\qquad$ and $\qquad$ .
I accept responsibility for completion of all courses required for both majors and all other degree requirements.
I understand the following:

- If I complete two majors with the same degree objective (e.g. both majors leading to a B.A.), I will receive a diploma that specifies two majors, but I will earn just one degree.
- I may not graduate with one major and later return to complete the other. Instead, I must complete requirements for both majors by the end of the quarter in which I apply for graduation. Further, to graduate with one major alone, I must formally drop the one that is not yet complete, and I will not later be readmitted to complete a second degree in the major I have dropped.
- No more than 8 units may be applied simultaneously toward upper-division requirements for both majors, with the exception of two majors both within the School of Social Ecology. For double majors within the School of Social Ecology, no upper-division major units may overlap since School requirements automatically overlap.
- Substitution of any course not listed on the major requirement sheet is acceptable only if approved by the School in which that major is housed. Substitution of breadth requirements must be approved by both schools.
